

Manners and Rules at Evacuation Sites

At evacuation sites, you will need to spend time with Japanese local residents. Difficult and inconvenient situation is expected, however, we rely on your cooperation in respecting Japanese cultural backgrounds as well as observing manners and rules that will bring comfortable evacuation time for us all.

1 Always have a spirit of mutual-concessions, mutual-aid while you are here.

2 Follow the rules of this evacuation site.

3 Have respect for other's privacy. Never infringe on others' private spaces.

4 Talk in a loud voice while chatting or using mobile phones is prohibited in this evacuation site.

5 Use of fire, smoking, and boozing are prohibited in this evacuation site.

6 Have consideration for the elderly, the handicapped, and persons with small children.



7 Every resident will have access to the food & other relief supplies. Before we start providing supplies, we need your patience in waiting in a queue. Please give priority to the elderly, the handicapped, and persons with small children.

8 After using the lavatory, leave it in a clean state for the next person.

9 We request your voluntariness in doing chores at this evacuation site.



10 We request you to separate garbage by types and to dispose them at designated garbage pits.

11 In case of emergency, includes sudden change in physical condition, immediately notice it to the site's staff.

12 If you have specific food restrictions or allergies, notice it to the site's staff.

13 Please look after your personal belongings by yourself. The site will have no responsibilities for any lost properties or robberies.

14 Please notice the site's staff when you leave this evacuation site to another place.
