## Features of this Night-time Junior High School


- Can learn 9 subjects and Ethics, Integrated learning, Special activities as day-time students do. (Legitimate Junior High School teachers teach each subject.)
- This is not a school for people who do not understand Japanese to learn Japanese.
- Need to attend classes from Monday through Friday, from 17:30 to 20:40.
- In case a student arrives late for school due to work, housework, etc. we will allow the student to join the class in the middle of the lesson.
- No tuition fee. Textbooks are provided for free. Each student shall bear the burden of appx. ¥10,000 per year for other learning materials.
- · As a rule, need to attend school from year 1 to year 3. 3 years of course of study is required for the completion.
- Japanese language supplemented classes can be provided for students with poor Japanese skill. However, it is only for Year 1 students' classes only.
- \*We do not accept students who just want to learn Japanese language. Japanese language supplemented classes are not provided for Year 2 & 3 students.
- After finished the whole course, student will be acknowledged as officially completed the Junior High School curriculum (you will be issued Diploma).

**XIt is prohibited to bring your child, or family to school.** 

\*We do not accept applicants with the purpose of taking specific subjects only, or using this institution as a Japanese language school.



# Requirements for applicants



- · Have not officially finished Elementary School or Junior High School course
- Officially finished the compulsory education curriculum, however, could not receive enough compulsory education due to reasons such as nonattendance, etc.
- Foreign nationals who have not complete curriculum that corresponds to Japan's compulsory education. (Require skills of simple Japanese conversation, hiragana, katakana)
