This year, Kawaguchi City commemorates the 90th year of its foundation since the incorporation as a city on April 1st, 1933.

Kawaguchi City have been developed with local manufacturing industries led by cast iron products and green industry that includes cultivation of garden plants and flowers. Today, owing to its favorable location that adjacent to the Metropolis of Tokyo along with convenient transportation systems, the City is broadly recognized as “One of the most comfortable city to live in”.
