[Asahi-Kankyo Center(garbage disposal plant) fire] Temporal Garbage Disposal Method till we get back the normal operation

We are afraid we have put all the residents to a great deal of trouble and inconvenience from the fire occurred at Asahi-Kankyo Center.

Till the restoration of the facility of Asahi-Kankyo Center is completed, we will partly alter garbage disposal rules. See the following for altered rules.

"Lighter"

Empty the content. Do not mix in Kitchen Garbage. Put in a bag and write "有害ごみ-Hazardous" on it. Take out to a "Ordinary Garbage" disposal pit.

"Broken articles (crockery, glass, tableware, etc.)"

Wrap the article in scrap papers. Do not mix in Kitchen Garbage, Put in a bag and write "われもの-Broken articles" on it. Take out to a "Ordinary Garbage" disposal pit.

XAs for the items above, be sure to put them in a bag separately from Kitchen Garbage.

"Lithium-ion Batteries and electrical home appliances with built-in Lithium-ion Batteries"

It causes fire. Never put them in ordinary garbage disposal bags.

When you dispose of small sized rechargeable dry cell batteries (Lithium-ion Batteries), bring them to recycle cooperating stores such as retailers of those batteries. As for recycle cooperating stores, please inquire Incorporated Association JBRC (03-6403-5673) for details.

When you dispose of batteries that are not covered by JBRC collection program and swollen Lithium-ion Batteries, and other electric home appliances with built-in Lithiumion Batteries, please cover the terminals with tape, etc.(completely insulated), then take out as "METAL" garbage.
